

MIGRA ROYALTY COMPETITION RULES & GUIDELINES

Requirements to be eligible to compete for MR/MS/MISS/MSTER MIGRA

1. Candidate has to be a member in good standing of MIGRA for at least 30 days prior to competition.
2. Has to host a minimum of one (1) candidate fundraiser with the proceeds going toward MIGRA charities.
3. Has to be judged publicly in western wear, entertainment, and public presentation.
4. Has to be judged privately in interview & horsemanship.
5. All entries must be submitted to the MIGRA Vice President no less than 10 days prior to competition. This includes your fundraiser.
6. All entries must include a Non-Refundable entry fee of \$25.00.
7. Contestants must provide a written Plan of Action consisting of goals for the MIGRA royalty team for the upcoming year. It must be in a sealed envelope with the contestant's name listed on front. They must turn in their music for entertainment at registration. The envelope will be given to the MIGRA Vice President to open and verify. They will be reviewed with the competition winners to build the team's final plan of action. Failure to provide a plan of action will result in a 2 point deduction from each judge's score sheet in the interview segment.
8. A willingness statement that accompanies the royalty packet shall be signed and turned in with the application form and \$25 non refundable deposit for entry fee
9. Royalty contestants and competition officials may NOT be under the influence of or consume alcohol/illegal drugs during active segments of the contest.

Competition officials include:

Master of Ceremonies, Stage Staff, Judges, and Auditors.

The competition committee will define active segments at the contest meeting held prior to the Royalty competition.
